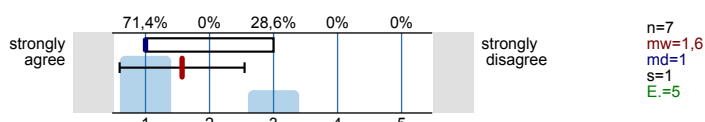
1.1) The course was well structured.



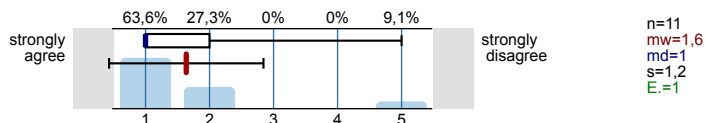
1.2) The choice of topics was well explained by the instructor.



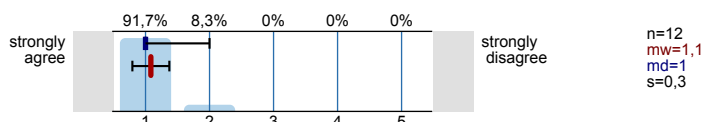
1.3) Recommended reading materials were useful in facilitating understanding of course content.



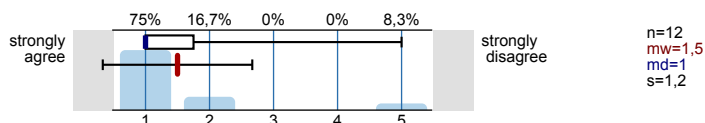
